Notes: We have a Toad Hill Road, but no Toad Hill! Maybe it was originally called Tote Hill Road when men used horses and oxen to tote supplies and equipment into the hills for logging jobs, and to tote sleds of logs and hemlock bark out.

Egypt is not named on current maps, but it was important enough to be named by early settlers. It is just north of Slope Mountain.

Slope Mountain is sometimes written/pronounced Sloop Mountain.

We have Butter Hill Road, but no Butter Hill. Someone along that road must have made some extraordinary butter!
