Chatham Veterans Memorial

The Chatham Veterans Memorial was created beside the Town House in 1990. In 2017 the Memorial was moved across the road to its present location, with pavers to remember the names of specific veterans, and a flag flies proudly above. In 2019, pieces of granite from the old foundation of the Town House were used to make benches at the memorial site.

We invite people to sponsor a stone paver for a veteran important to them or a forgotten veteran from one of our earlier wars. The only stipulation is that the paver is in memory of a veteran who was a resident of Chatham at some point in his/her life. The veteran you honor does not need to be one of your relatives; you may remember any veteran who was a resident of Chatham.

If you would like to sponsor a paver in the name of a veteran, you can do it! Just print and fill out the form below, include a check for \$150.00 payable to the Chatham Historical Society, and mail it all to the address indicated. We will have your paver engraved and added to the memorial.

Want to honor more than one veteran? Just make copies of the form, and remember to include \$150.00 per paver.

A list of veterans is available. If you know an eligible veteran that we have not included, please let us know! You can also make a small donation to help remember one of our "forgotten" veterans from one of the early wars in our history.

The 12 x 12 paving stones can be engraved with as many as 6 lines of up to 12 characters each. Each line of text is automatically centered.
